SUSTAINABILITY -BETWEEN COMFORT AND CONSCIOUS RESPONSIBILITY



At Schenna Resort, sustainability is not just a buzzword but is actively integrated into everyday life. The resort pursues a comprehensive sustainability strategy and is working towards certification according to the international GSTC* standard. In an interview, **Heidi**, **Stefan**, **Michaela**, **Peter**, and **Florian** discuss the challenges and successes on the path to creating a more mindful, eco-friendly vacation experience – for both guests and staff alike.

What led to the decision to pursue sustainability certification?


Heidi: Sustainability must be visible – for guests but also for employees. We decided to take this path with the GSTC certification, which unfolds in five phases and undergoes an audit. It takes time and commitment to ensure that sustainability is truly practiced in all areas of the resort.

Where do you make this tangible for the guest?

Stefan: For guests, sustainability today must be a visible experience. You can see it in our photovoltaic system or even in the towels provided in the wellness area. In the luxury segment, there's a fine line between sacrifice and comfort. Waste separation and a more selective buffet are aspects we consciously implement. However, we make the dining options more varied, which often pleasantly surprises our guests. Occasionally, we do get complaints, but our skill lies in presenting sustainable solutions in a way that they are perceived as added value.

What environmentally friendly measures are already in place?

Michaela: In housekeeping, we took the first step two years ago. Guests no longer automatically receive their slippers in the room but can use their own. Towels are no longer provided in excess; instead, they are placed mindfully. We use eco-friendly liquid detergents with ECO labels, and single-use bottles are a thing of the past. A next step is the use of steam cleaners to further reduce the consumption of cleaning products.



How does the Schenna Resort reduce energy consumption?

Stefan: Our energy supply is a significant topic. We can generate around 40 percent of the energy we need – both electricity and heat. We have extensively modernized our energy systems: triple-glazed windows, insulated facades, and an intelligent BUS system for the air conditioning. The shading also plays a huge role in this. All of this contributes to sustainability and significantly reduces energy consumption compared to years ago. It's an exciting area to explore heat protection to efficiently manage air conditioning while also utilizing that heat where we need it.

Erwarten das die Gäste bereits?

Peter: Of course, guests also expect comfort, and we are aware of that. However, more and more guests are specifically looking for sustainably operated hotels. Our job is to communicate this as well as possible, because we have already achieved a lot without making a big fuss about it. This applies not only to the hotel industry, but also to other sectors.

Heidi: Yes, we are actually seeing a clear trend of guests asking specifically what we are doing in terms of sustainability. Topics such as towels and bath slippers are often welcomed. It is important that future generations can live as well as we do - we have to be open to that. We worked on a comprehensive checklist and were surprised at how well organised we already are. Now it is a question of making sustainability visible, through the morning paper, information in the rooms and training of our employees. We want everyone to know.





'Hotels and holidays are always a matter of taste. Many appreciate our family presence - whether in the evening or during the day while hiking or cycling. This family atmosphere brings us closer to our guests and ensures honest feedback. Sustainability does not mean taking something away from anyone. Rather, we focus on making the experience more mindful and valuable. This will help us in the future as well.' It's often the little things that can make a big difference. How do you see it?



Florian: As a young person, it's easiest for me to focus on reducing waste and minimizing or eliminating packaging. It's important to me not to use a car when it's avoidable. However, there's a balancing act between guests who are already thinking sustainably and those who are not quite there yet. We need solutions that satisfy everyone. But we already have a good plan for that.

Stefan: Media plays a key role in promoting the trend towards sustainability. Sometimes it is more sustainable to use things for longer, rather than constantly renewing them. That is why we consciously invest in neutral and timeless products and colours. This, too, is a contribution to sustainability.

Heidi: A guest recently said to me, 'Everything looks so new.' This shows us that we've made good choices. But it is only now that we realise that we also have to talk about it. Sustainability has always been a matter of course for us. It's nice that guests are increasingly looking for it.

What about viticulture?

Florian: Wine has always been a natural product. Many winegrowers are returning to biodynamic production. In viticulture, you can clearly see how energy-efficient and sustainable practices are – without herbicides and with minimal water use in the cellar.

Stefan: We produce around 60,000 bottles and sell the wine almost exclusively at the hotel or directly to our guests. This allows us to avoid long supply chains.



What might the guest of the future look like?

Heidi: I am happy about the families, couples and seniors with grandchildren, but also single travelers that we are currently attracting. It's a gift that young and old come together here. Every hotel finds its guests, and we are, of course, also considering new markets.



22 YEARS OF HOSPITALITY WITH HEART

Sonja started her career as a bartender at Lake Garda before deciding to work at the reception. To prepare for this role, she completed a special course for receptionists. Over the course of 22 years, the hotel has transformed from a small guesthouse into a prestigious establishment. What she particularly appreciates is that it is lovingly run by the owner family.

Friendliness and the ability to listen well are the key factors for good receptionists. Guests particularly appreciate this. On the other hand, unfriendliness is an absolute taboo, and patience is essential in stressful situations.



"Guests have become more demanding and their expectations have risen over the last few decades," says Sonja. And it's precisely in this that she finds her motivation to remain friendly and to find solutions for the guests. One of the most memorable moments of her career was the celebration at Schenna Castle for the hotel's 30th anniversary with our guests, where she was honored for her 10-year anniversary as an employee. 'It still feels like it was just yesterday,' she recalls. 'Yes, you experience many of life's moments up close,' Sonja reflects.

Outside of work, Sonja loves spending time with her young son, who is her top priority. She enjoys reading and appreciates the small-town life in Meran.

Sonja values her work at the reception because it is varied and challenging, and she would choose this profession again anytime. When she goes on vacation herself, she pays particular attention to reviews and describes herself as a rather demanding guest. 'Switching to the other side is also helpful to better understand my work. You can do this job for years, and still, something new happens that you've never experienced before. That's exciting,' Sonja laughs.



FROM CONSTRUCTION TECHNICIAN TO **OENOLOGIST**

Georg Weger, the cellar master of the Pföstl Winery at Schenna Resort, has had an unusual journey. Originally trained as a construction technician, he quickly realized that this profession didn't bring him joy. Through fruit farming, he eventually discovered his passion for viticulture, leading him to pursue a four-year education at the agricultural school for fruit and wine cultivation. Georg gained practical experience not only in South Tyrol but also at a winery in Tuscany and in Germany, where he managed a vineyard. About ten years ago, his friend Stefan Pföstl suggested the idea of establishing their own winery. Since then, they have cultivated around 4 hectares of their own vineyards, along with approximately 3 hectares sourced from carefully selected local suppliers.



Elegance, lightness and delicate winemaking

Georg places special emphasis on the elegance of his wines. They should not only pair well with food but also have an enjoyable drinkability. In production, Georg focuses on gentle vinification, highlighting this by avoiding maceration. Their top wine, Valpitan, matures in French oak barrels, which they aim to use for as long as possible.

The terroir

The vineyards of the Pföstl Winery are located around Meran, primarily on light, acidic soils. The underlying rock is granite and gneiss, two very hard stones rich in quartz and feldspar. The vineyards are located from Schenna and Tscherms to Marling and Riffian. Both types of rock impart a distinctive structure to the wines.

'While the term "mineral" is often debated in the wine world and frequently used as a marketing term, it's fair to say that the hard underlying rocks produce wines with a crisp acidity. I like to describe the white wines from these soils as "vibrant," while our red wines are elegant and invigorating,' says Georg, summarizing his wines.





A passion for German Riesling and a love for Ducati

In his free time, Georg Weger enjoys relaxing over a good meal or riding his Ducati. During his time in Germany, he developed a fondness for German Riesling. He often returns there to exchange ideas with fellow winemakers and gather new inspiration for his work.

The Pföstl winery stands for a harmonious blend of tradition, elegance, and modern viticulture, with a focus on high-quality enjoyment.

NERTIL - THE ART OF SIMPLICITY: **PLEASANT CUISINE**


At home, it's the men who wield the cooking spoon. However, the love for cooking comes from an even older tradition: it was his mother, or rather his grandmother, who passed on this passion for the kitchen. So where did he learn his craft? In Italy, specifically in Bozen, at the Hotel Colle. There, he met his first head chef, who made a lasting impression on him. She taught him that often the simplest things are the most important. A nut cake without a recipe? No problem for his former boss, who baked solely by instinct and with a lot of heart.

For **Nertil**, cooking isn't complicated. "Less is more" – this motto runs through his kitchen. His goal is not to overload the ingredients, but rather to let each dish have a clear direction where the individual flavors can shine. At the Olive restaurant in Hotel Mitterplatt, he presents Italian cuisine with an international twist. Every Monday, he serves Tyrolean classics like Kaiserschmarrn (shredded pancake) and homemade Schlutzkrapfen (Tyrolean dumplings).

Why does his Italian cuisine taste so good? Nertil is convinced that the key to his delicious Italian cuisine lies in the quality of the ingredients. He focuses on regional products and ensures that his food travels as few kilometers as possible. Many of the herbs he uses come directly from his own herb garden. Additionally, he uses less flour to create lighter, more digestible dishes. This commitment to quality and freshness enhances the flavors, making his cuisine so exceptional.

For Nertil, vegetarian cuisine is essential, but it must be well-balanced—achieving the right harmony of flavors is key. At Mitterplatt, one must certainly try the chanterelle mushrooms when they are in season, as they are a highlight of the menu. Nertil's personal favorite dish combines meat and fish with a generous amount of vegetables, creating a variety that makes his dishes uniquely special.

Nertil has worked in renowned establishments like Hotel Colle in Bozen and the Michelin-starred Restaurant Sissi in Meran. For the past five years, he has been the head chef at Mitterplatt in Schenna Resort. What is important to him in life and at work? "Family and children come first, then the job," he says. Because when you're happy at home, you can also create great things in the kitchen. And this happiness is truly reflected in the flavors of his dishes.






